






Works of the 2nd grade students on the mosaic. Children are aware of the ancient technique of the mosaic and produce their own works using simpler materials.





Work of the 2nd grade students concerning geometrical constructions with line drawing elements
















Students welcome autumn. Each student designs his own tree leaf and the result is an original creation at the school entrance











Paintings made by students, three years ago, in the framework of a project concerning the refugee question.










Works of the 3rd graders studying the perspective drawing. Students draw a room in one-point perspective.

In previous years, we made the application examples of Traditional Turkish Arts with 10th graders. We applied our work on the porcelain plate.








